Dear St. Stephen's Family,

Our Treasurer, John Fortman will also be on hand and together we will answer any questions you may have.

Our theme for our annual pledge drive this year is "Rooted in Abundance". I give thanks that this is a true statement about the people to St. Stephen's. We are blessed with an abundance of talent in this community which is leveraged generously and with love to further the mission and ministry of the community we love. And it is also true that we cannot do all that we do without your financial support. Therefore, I ask you to thoughtfully and prayerfully consider how you will support St. Stephen's in 2024. Your formalized commitment, no matter the amount will help us to make smart and informed decisions about what we will be able to do in 2024.


